Leo has had over thirty solo exhibitions in Australia and New Zealand and has taken part in numerous group exhibitions in Australia and internationally. His work is represented in many private and public collections, including National Gallery of Australia, Maitland Regional Gallery, Brisbane City Hall Gallery, New England Region Art Gallery and Museum, Coffs Harbour Regional Gallery and the University of Newcastle and the Bundanon Collection

Leo Robba is an artist, writer and curator, who was born in Bundaberg, Queensland, in 1962. He has written for The Sydney Morning Herald and Arts Profile Magazine. He is also known for organising and leading art expeditions to remote and iconic destinations.

Leo has a Masters of Fine Art from Newcastle University exploring the topic "Regionalism in Australian Landscape Painting" and is currently doing research as part of his PhD scholarship at the ANU, Canberra, the topic "The Artist's Garden: Humanising the Landscape." He graduated from the Queensland College of Art in1982 and moved to Sydney in 1983.

He is represented by King Street Gallery on William, Sydney, Bowen Galleries, Wellington, NZ and lives and works in Springwood, in the Blue Mountains.
