February Monthly Meeting Demonstration—Ruth Dengate

Ruth became an exhibiting member of the Royal Art Society in the early 1980s. Her teachers in watercolour and oils were Garrett Kingsley and Ron Stannard.

Ruth held her first exhibition at Windsor, New South Wales in 1983, and also exhibited with other female artists in an exhibition entitled 'Women in the Hawkesbury'. In 1994 she had an exhibition of Mixed Media, watercolours and oils at the Braemar Gallery in Springwood.

Ruth joined the Society of Mountain Artists in 2001, and has since won many awards for her still life paintings in watercolour, oils and pastels. She has won 'Best in Show' for a watercolour judged by John Wilson, also a First Prize in oils and Second Prize in watercolour judged by Warwick Fuller.

Ruth lives in Wentworth Falls in the Blue Mountains.

'Tarella' is an 1890 weatherboard cottage containing family and Blue Mountains social history displays.

The Historical Society plans to have an art show in March & would welcome paintings of the house etc. Details to come

The Blue Mountains Historical Society was established in 1946 by the Blue Mountains County Council, later moving to Tarella. Hobby's Reach research centre and the historic cottage Tarella are two hidden treasures situated on the original road over the Blue Mountains constructed by William Cox in 1814. They are situated in one and a half hectares of gardens and grounds. Lieutenant Thomas Hobby constructed the straight section of road directly outside our premises and we recognise that fact by naming the research centre Hobby's Reach.

Members who painted plein-air at Dry Ridge Winery last year in May have requested that we have a plein-air day when the autumn colours are on the vines. We are still planning when this will be but it will need to be in April.
