THE FIRST FIVE ARE USING ALL THE PAPER, THEN I DECIDED TO DO THREE SMALL CIRCLES, THE FIRST BEING 'THREE MACHIATOS' HAVING DIFFICULTY CONTAINING THE WATERCOLOUR WITHIN THE CIRCLES I DECIDED TO RUN CIRCLES THROUGH MY PRINTING PRESS, THUS MAKING AN IMPRESSION IN THE PAPER. THIS IS HOW I ACHIEVED ALL THE CIRCULAR PAINTINGS. THE IDEAS FOR MORE AND MORE PAINTINGS TOO ARE IN MY HEAD.
