- change at Parramatta and stay on same platform (1) Catch next train, which goes to the North Shore.
- Get off at Town Hall (platform 3) walk down stairs to platforms 5/6 and catch Bondi train to Martin Place walk to State Library This avoids the crush at Central and has fewer stairs.
